1. Location

Transit to Falmouth at midnight

2. Activity Summary

Completed transit to Kiel. Science party disembarked, microbiology samples were offloaded to World Courier and vessel then continued transit to Falmouth. End of Expedition 347.

3. Weather

Overcast, wave heights of 0.5-1.25 m; winds SW, 16-19 kts, gusting to 21 kts; Max 10° C. Next 24 hrs, Isolated showers with fog / mist, wave heights of 1.5-2 m, winds SW, 25-30 kts. 10° C. A deep low will move over the North Sea and Scandinavia, developing small lows off this parent system, bringing the likelihood of fog and showers and strong SW winds.

Continue transit to Falmouth.
