2. Activity summary

The vessel remained at anchor waiting on weather, at the Townsville anchorage site. A supply boat delivered spare ALN drill bits in the afternoon. The impact of tropical cyclone Ului on proposed vessel movements was reassessed at 10:00 and 15:00 by the ESO Operations Superintendant, Bluestone Party Chief, Master of the Maya and the Co-chiefs.

5. Weather

Sea state: slight (3) with swell of <1.25m becoming moderate (4) with a swell of 1.25 – 2.5m; wind direction SE force 5 becoming 6/7 by midnight (22-33 knots); partly cloudy becoming overcast late afternoon; 28°C.

Next 24 hrs: Sea state moderate to rough with swell of 3.5 m in open waters; wind direction SE 25 – 33 knots reaching 30–40 knots offshore; scattered showers. A gale warning is in place
