2. Operations Report

All crew and Science Party members joined the Kaimei at Yokosuka. The ship left port at 1000 hrs JST, with departure broadcast live on YouTube. All staff were given a full onboard safety briefing and then prepared cabins.

Following lunch MarE3 staff met with the Captain. The decision was taken to lay c. 3 km off Yokosuka to ride out forecast poor weather, using this time to prepare equipment and laboratories and familiarize SP members with ship layout and protocols.

A kick-off meeting among Science Party with MWJ was held for brief self-introduction, an introduction to routine GPC work flow and familiarization with the work assignment plan.

The first Daily Meeting with ESO and MarE3 onshore staff was held at 1600hrs JST, where Lena Maeda updated the team on progress and requested meetings to be held at 1700hrs JST from the 16th of April as this would allow time for recovery of GPC corer to deck and full reporting of daily progress.
