2. Operations Report

The ship started approaching the port at 0700 hrs and came alongside at 0900 hrs. In the morning, two core containers were offloaded and replaced with empty core containers. The core liner container was offloaded in order to load additional core liner, and then returned onboard. Additional lab consumables were also loaded before lunch time. In the afternoon, provisions and potable water were supplied. All cargo work was completed by 1400 hrs. Half of GPC operation team and lab techs, or one third of the ship's crew disembarked.

A very well attended live broadcast with undergraduate school students of four universities in Shikoku was held from 1215 hrs to 1300 hrs. Co-Chief Michi Strasser introduced the scientific objectives of the expedition, Co-Chief Ken Ikehara demonstrated the GPC assembly on deck and collected cores in No.3 laboratory, and scientist Kana Jitsuno explained her shipboard tasks.
