### 2. Operations Report

Crew change for ship crew completed at 02:00 to/from the OSV Gaspee.

We completed the final housekeeping on the deck to ensure all equipment was secured for the lowering and raising of the boat operations and the short transit to the new location MV-08AB. Preparations were completed safely and in good time, and preloading complete by 17:30. Unfortunately, the weather increased above the safe working limit for running in the casing and so we had to stop operations until it ameliorated sufficiently. The weather came through 24 hours earlier than the usually reliable forecast. Still waiting on weather at 24:00.

#### 3. Science Report

Processing of logging data continued, and the X501 team focused on preparations for pump testing and groundwater sampling at the new location. Both shifts participated in planning meetings to go through workflow and were busy testing equipment and sampling setups. High level discussions were ongoing regarding planned depths for pump testing at the next hole using the data obtained from Hole M0112A.




Figure 1 A rainy view to the working deck while waiting for the vessel to be safely at location. Stewart@ECORD\_IODP3\_rainy\_day.
