Atlantis Massif Serpentinization and Life, 2015**

**1. Location**

30° 13.3' N 42° 14.7' W

**2. Operations Report**

Waiting on weather throughout the day. During this period multibeam data was collected in increasing poor sea conditions. A single CTD cast was conducted over proposed site AM-09A.

**3. Weather**

SW winds 22 – 30knots blowing steadily. Building to rough seas with W swell of up to 4 – 5m. Scattered showers with patchy cloud but otherwise good visibility. Maximum temperature of 25.7°C.

Next 24 hours: Monitoring wind and swell. Swell expected to drop later in the day with SW winds at ~20kn.

Cloudy with scattered showers due to a front passing through.

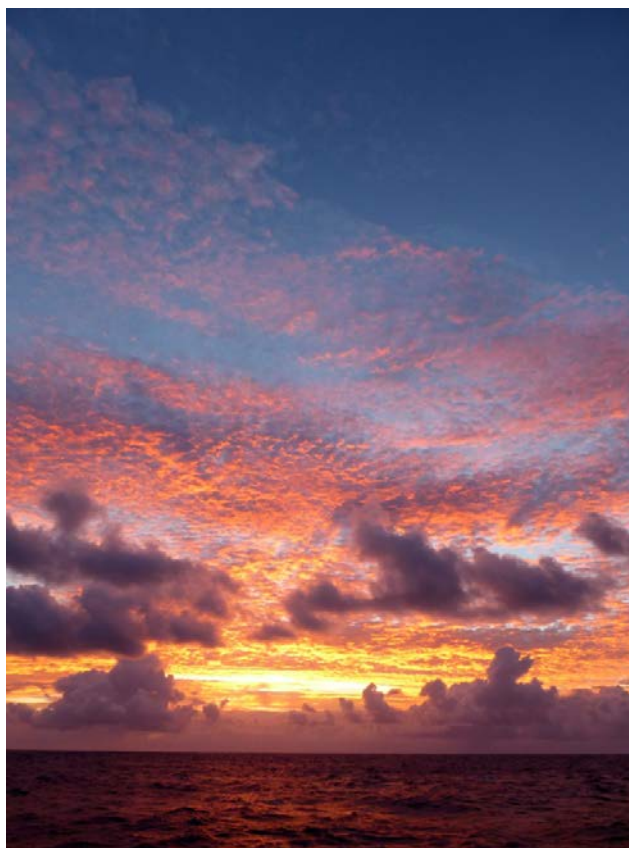
**4. Planned Activity for the next 24 hours**
