IODP-Canada organizes a summer school in 2010 on:

Ocean and Climate Changes in Polar and Subpolar environments

- PhD students and postdoctoral fellows from ECORD countries are welcome to apply. The summer school will focus on paleoceanography and paleoclimatology at high latitudes and will include lectures, lab work, fieldwork in the St. Lawrence Estuary and field trips in the St. Lawrence lowlands
- The registration cost is **1,500 \$ CD** (before March 31st 2010; 1, 800 CAD after that date). It includes accommodation and most meals, local transport, access to the ship, laboratories, etc. It does not include the air flight ticket to Montreal and extrapersonal costs.
