September 4-5, 2012, Avignon, France**

1) From the list of actions of the Granada meeting

Action EMA (PM): to update the 3-fold ECORD leaflet with recent ECORD changes/new members by the beginning of November 2012.

Action ESSAC-EMA-ESO (CE, PM, JGP, AS): to continue contacting ECORD teachers for feedback by forwarding them a set of concrete questions about the classroom how has the experience been useful for them after SOR/JR expeditions.

Action EMA (GC), ESO (AG): Currently for the selection of additional core replicas, it is needed to have one core replica from geohazards and another one from the deep biosphere. Gilbert Camoin will contact Anne Le Friant (Exp 340) and Katrina Edwards and Albert Gerdes will contact Kai Uwe Hinrichs (Exp 337) to help selecting a core (nice core that also tells a story).

Action ESSAC: to contact authors of the IODP book when the manuscript is available to prepare ECORD highlights for a public audience.

To be further discussed at our next Outreach and Education meeting in Salamanca.

Action EMA (PM): to continue the collection of web statistics for ECORD, ESO and ESSAC websites.

Action EMA, ESO, ESSAC (PM, AS, JGP): Updates of ECORD websites to be continued.

Action ESO (AS): to collect unpublished expedition photos from MSP expedition participants for building up the ECORD photo archives.

Action EMA (MB,PM) - ESO - ESSAC: to finish the assigned summary sections for the ECORD in Wikipedia text.

2) Reports of recent IODP-ECORD meetings/events

Action EMA (GC): to ask Jan de Leeuw to note for discussion at the next January SIPCom meeting about having integrated outreach funding at IODP Forum level for the booths, e.g. IODP booth at AGU 2013.

Action ESSAC Chair, ESO Managers and EMA Director: to write by late September, 2012 a letter to the community that the new ECORD structure has been approved. To be published on October 1st , 2012 (one year before the new phase).

Action ESSAC: to notify Magellan+ workshop participants about the 5 000 euros workshop scientist support opportunity.

Action EMA (PM) and ESSAC (JGP): Update information about workshops on the ESSAC and ECORD webpages/database.

Action ESO (AS): to find video footages for the Baltic Trailer (Co-chief Scientists of the Baltic Sea Expedition, MARUM video maker, etc.).

3) ECORD publications/materials

Action EMA (PM): to update the ECORD folder with new ECORD members and insert for the business card and to reprint it by October 2012

Action EMA (PM): to begin working on the ECORD Annual Report 2012 by late October 2012 to be released by February 2013. Gilbert is the Editor.

Action All: to meet to discuss the Annual Report at the next ECORD Council meeting in November 2013.

Action ESO, ESSAC, EMA (GC, MB): to provide Patricia with photos for ECORD Calendar 2013.

Action EMA (GC): to bring the update of the Arctic brochure for discussion at the next Vision task Force meeting

Action ESO (AS): to postpone the production of a new MSP flyer to the next phase of IODP

Action Albert: to respond Tadashi Yosahizawa (CDEX) that the information acknowledging the funders and technical services be explicitly stated for the Expedition 337 documentary (CDEX use, credits, distribution). And to request that in the case that just a few documentary images are used, the user should to apply ECORD's logo on the images.

Action EMA (PM): to create a flyer for the outreach booth, answering the question "How to get involved in ECORD/ IODP?" addressed to scientists and students.

Action EMA (PM): to update ECORD webpages (IODP 2013-2023, press and media, etc.) as discussed during the meeting.

Action ESSAC (JGP) - EMA (PM):: to update the website with: the new delegates' names, new members, and remove the list of dates for the SAS Panel Members.

Action ESSAC-EMA: to post information about Magellan+ online on the ESSAC website with a link to the ECORD front page. It needs to gather information from Jochen about the contents.

Action ESSAC (JGP) - EMA (PM): to add a link on ESSAC/ECORD education online to the project between Exp 340 and a French school in Marseille on when it is posted on the IODP-France website.

Action ESO (AS): to update the website with the most recent Baltic Expedition information.
