#3 CIB update

- #3 CIB meeting was held on 30 – 31 March 2015 at JAMSTEC Yokohama Institute for Earth Sciences (YES)
- Fifteen consensus items, including
 - Appreciated SEP's review of CHIKYU proposals. (CIB Consensus 0315-03)
 - Supported creation of ADP proposal. (CIB Consensus 0315-04)
 - Supported NanTroSEIZE operations for JFY2015-18. (CIB Consensus 0315-05)
 - Invited only CPPs for riser proposal for the next proposal submission deadline (1 Oct. 2015) due to the current Chikyu proposal pressure. (CIB Consensus 0315-06)
 - Decided keep three riser projects/proposal (537B, 698, 781B) without any priority. Not support PCT activities until an appropriate window of CHIKYU opens. (CIB Consensus 0315-07)



#3 CIB update

- Recommended establishment of a riserless Project Coordination Team for Proposal 865. (CIB Consensus 0315-08)
 - Based on the above consensus 0315_08, the first PCT meeting for IODP Proposal 865 was held on 1-2 October 2015 in Bremen.



#3 CIB update

- Endorsed the SEP’s recommendation for Proposal 871-Pre (Lord Howe Riser Crustal Evolution) to develop Full proposal and invites Full proposal development workshop proposal. (CIB Consensus 0315-09)
 - CDEX received “Full-proposal development workshop” proposal from 871-Pre Pls by 30 April 2015 and discussed among the group.
- The CIB reviewed ‘Full proposal development Workshop’ proposal for IODP Proposal 871-Pre. The CIB endorsed implementation of the workshop and formation of a Proposal Advisory Team (PAT) for the workshop. (CIB Consensus 0315-16)
 - Based on the above consensus 0315_09 and 16, Full proposal development workshop for IODP Proposal 871-Pre was held on 26 – 28 August 2015 in Tokyo.



#3 CIB update

- Approved “Chikyu Staffing Procedures”, “Chikyu Onboard Measurements Guidelines”, “Chikyu 3rd Party Tools and Instruments Policy” and “Chikyu 2nd Post Expedition Meeting Guidelines”. (CIB Consensus 0315-10)
- Approved revised version of “IODP Proposal Confidentiality Policy” and “IODP Site Survey Data Confidentiality Policy”. (CIB Consensus 0315-11)
- Recognized the importance of Nagoya protocol and its potential effects on the future Chikyu IODP operations. (CIB Consensus 0315-12)

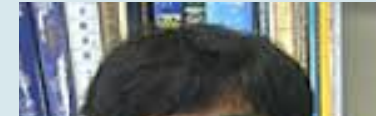
