






# ECORD MAGELLANPLUS WORKSHOP Drilling the Tonian to Cryogenian boundary in the Inner Hebrides, Scotland

### Science Goals:

- Recover the highest resolution record of the late Tonian to interrogate Earth's descent into the global 'Sturtian' glaciation.
- Progress towards defining the unratified basal Cryogenian Global Stratotype Section and Point (GSSP).
